Principal's Corner

Dear Roadrunner Families – Clovis Unified and Nelson Elementary have rules and procedures in place to help ensure that student safety is first and foremost, and that effectiveness and efficiency are maximized for all shareholders. To those ends, we do have procedures for our drop-off and pick-up zones, and rules for parking on campus. Please help us keep all roadrunners safe, and maximize efficiency by following the rules. In the drop-off/pick-up zone in front of kindergarten:

Please pull forward as far as you can in a drop-off zone. If you need to walk your child to their classroom or to the office, find an actual parking space, or park on the street. We have plenty of street parking in front of the school.

Do not exit your car in the drop-off/pick-up zone, and do not park in the drop-off zones.

Pedestrians should NOT cut through the drop-off lot, but please be vigilant and watchful just in case they do.

All cars should turn RIGHT onto Spruce when exiting the front drop-off zone. It would alleviate many traffic tie-ups.

Never drop-off or pick-up at the crosswalk in front of the school. It is illegal and unsafe.

I've worked at five school sites in CUSD over 26 years and I can say that Nelson has the easiest and fastest access of any that I know! KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Registration for both Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten started Wednesday, March 1, 2017. If you have not yet registered your child(ren) for kindergarten, please come to the main office as soon as possible to get registered. To be eligible for Kindergarten, your child must turn five on or before September 1, 2017.

Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is a two-year program and to register, your child must turn five between Sept. 2 - Dec. 2, 2017.

Our T-K and K classes are half day classes only. We have an afternoon Campus Club program for those who require after school care. You will be given the opportunity to let us know your preference of an AM or PM class at registration.
