Attendance Concerns

The state of California is tightening school attendance requirements. Any student with 3 or more absences is considered "at-risk" and the school and District are required to follow up. Parents are asked to clear absences before 9:00 AM and bring in doctor notes when students are out for appointments, illness or absent for an extended illness.

Three (3) or more tardies are also considered as being "at-risk" for attendance also.

Free School Meals
