KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Registration for both Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten started Wednesday, March 1, 2017. If you have not yet registered your child(ren) for kindergarten, please come to the main office as soon as possible to get registered. To be eligible for Kindergarten, your child must turn five on or before September 1, 2017.

Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is a two-year program and to register, your child must turn five between Sept. 2 - Dec. 2, 2017.

Our T-K and K classes are half day classes only. We have an afternoon Campus Club program for those who require after school care. You will be given the opportunity to let us know your preference of an AM or PM class at registration.

The EECU branch located on the Clovis West campus was awarded the Fresno Compact Award.

Clovis West Girls Basketball clinched their 12th straight TRAC Championship with a record of 117-3. The girls also clinched their 5th straight Valley Championship. This is the first D1 Central Section team to ever accomplish this and tied the school record for 30 wins in a season. The team earned #1 seed for the Southern California Regional Championships, the first time a Central Section team has ever been seeded #1. Congratulations to Coach Campbell as he was selected as one of the 5 Finalists for the Naismith National Coach of the Year.
