KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Registration for both Kindergarten and Transitional Kindergarten will be on Wednesday, March 1 beginning at 8:30am. To speed the actual process of registering on March 1st, you may pick up a registration packet in the main office starting Tuesday, Feb. 21st.

To be eligible for Kindergarten, your child must turn five on or before September 1, 2017.

Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is a two-year program and to register, your child must turn five between Sept. 2 - Dec. 2, 2017.

Our T-K and K classes are half day classes only. We have an afternoon Campus Club program for those who require after school care. You will be given the opportunity to let us know your preference of an AM or PM class at registration.

Five Day Rule for Clearing Absence

In order for the District to determine the reason for a student absence, it is necessary for parents/guardians to contact the school site attendance office and clear the student absence. The parent/guardian should contact the school the day the student returns, and must contact the site within five days of the student's return to school following the student's absence. The parent/guardian must provide the site with a reason for the student's absence.

If the parent/guardian does not contact the school site to clear an absence within five days of the student's return to school, the absence will remain "un-cleared". An un-cleared absence is not considered an excused absence under education code section 48205. Therefore, un-cleared absences will be considered unexcused and could lead to a student receiving a Notification of Truancy letter in accordance with education code section 48260.5.
